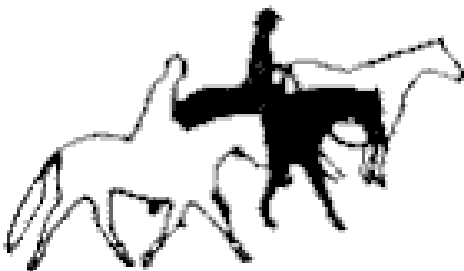
## Annual Meeting
