

WARNING

Under Nebraska Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to sections 25-21, 249 to 25-1, 253. Also under South Dakota Law.

25-21, 251

Except as provided in section 25-21, 252, (1) an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, or any other person, which includes a corporation, limited liability company, or partnership, shall not be liable for an injury to or the death of a participant resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities and (2) no participant nor participant's representative shall make any claim against, maintain an action against, or recover from an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, or any other person for injury, loss, damage, or death of the participant resulting from any of the inherent risks of equine activities.

A WAIVER MUST BE SIGNED BEFORE INDIVIDUALS ARE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN PQHA (PLAINS QUARTER HORSE ASSOCIATION) EVENTS. THIS WAIVER COVERS PARTICIPATION IN ALL 2010 PQHA EVENTS.

Anyone showing a Stallion does so at their own risk and needs to have it under control at all times. If Stallion acts up and causes trouble you may be asked to leave the arena.
